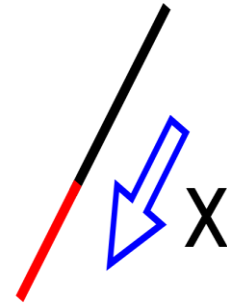


# Praying *salah* when travelling

travelling

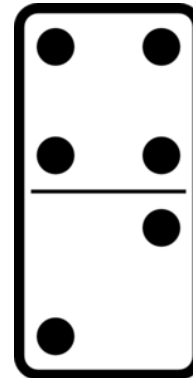
# Salat al-qasr

- Method same as daily *salah*
- Difference:

## 1. *Niyyah*

I am praying -----  
two rak'at, qasr,  
*wajib/ mustahabb*  
*qurbatan ilallah*

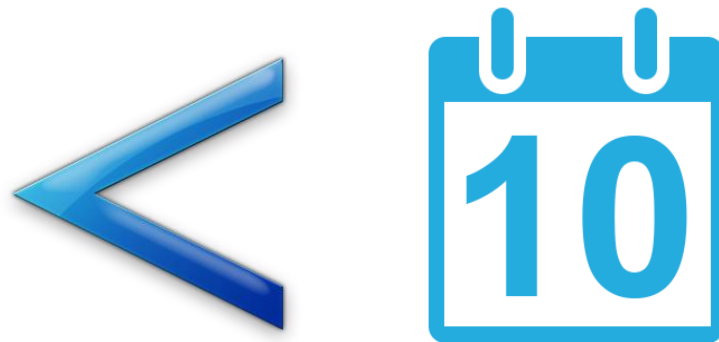
## 2. Number of *rak'at*:



# *When do we pray Salat al-qasr*



**The distance of the entire return journey must be  
27.5 miles (approximately 44 kilometres) or more**



The duration of time the *musafir* spends at his destination must be less than ten days.



The intention and purpose of travel must not be to do something *haram*



Frequent travelers such as pilots cannot shorten their *salah* as travelling is part of their lifestyle



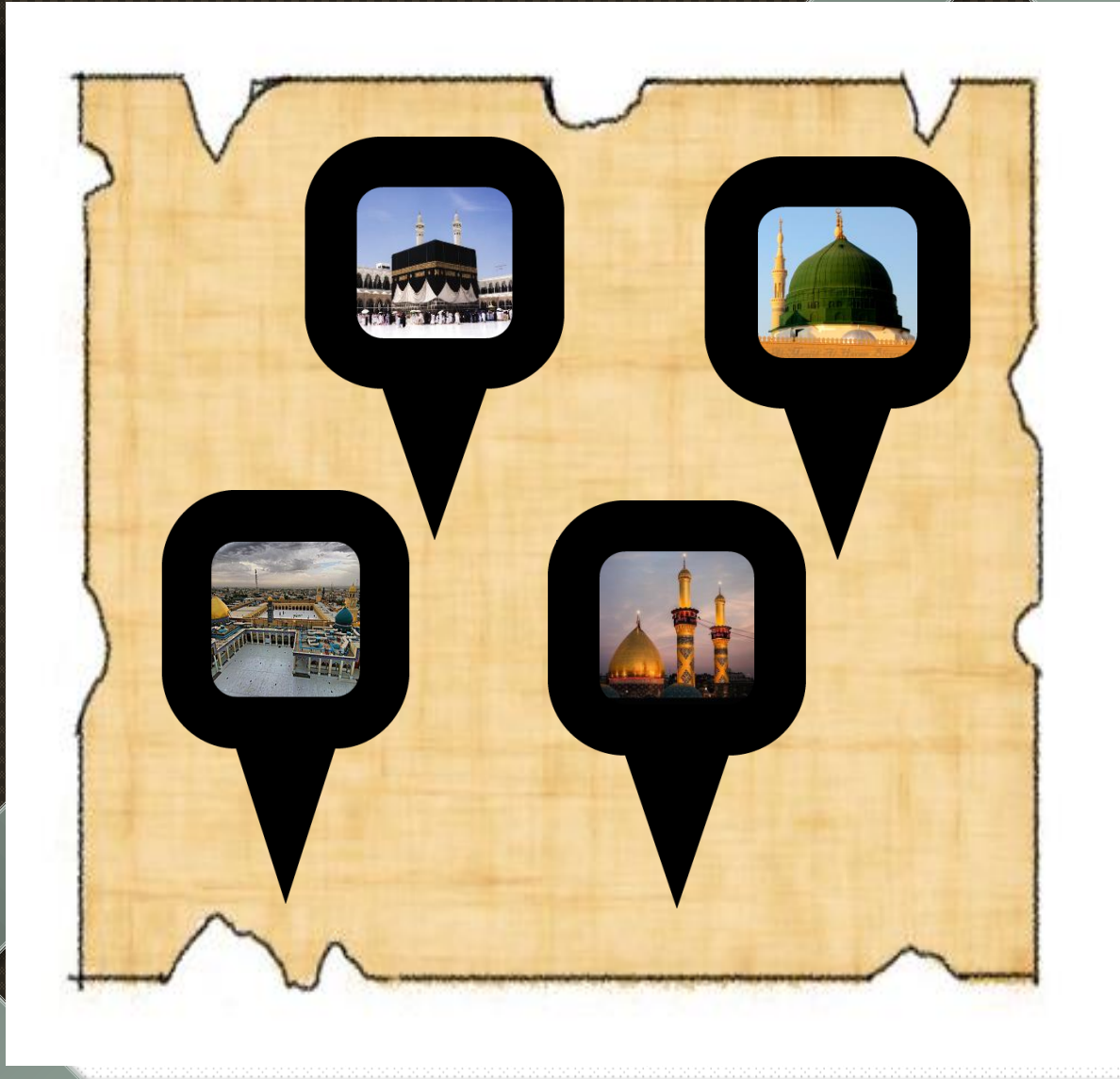


**A person cannot pray *salat al-qasr* in their

# Du'a before travelling
