Characters

Ahmed

Hamid Bhai (Barber)

Man with long, shabby hair

Narrator

Narrator: One day Ahmed decided to go to the barber because he needed a haircut and a beard trim

(At the barber shop)

Ahmed: Salaam Alaykum Hamid Bhai. How are you today?

Hamid Bhai: I'm fine Thank You. How about you?

Ahmed: I am well Alhamdulillah. Today, I need a good haircut and beard trim please

Hamid Bhai: Sure, sure...come on in. Take a seat

(Ahmed takes a seat in the barber's chair. They do some small talk about the weather, the cost of food prices and some politics)

Hamid Bhai: You know Ahmed...I don't believe that God exists.

Ahmed: Why do you say that Hamid Bhai?
