

Conditions of Wudu

Activity

1. Give each student some playdough
2. Ask them to create their dream bedroom. Give them about 10 minutes
3. If you have enough playdough ask them to set their creation aside for later. Otherwise try and take a picture of each student's model
4. Give each student a blank piece of paper and some pencils and colour pencils
5. Ask them to design their dream bedroom on the piece of paper
6. Once they have completed their plan on paper, ask them to make another model with playdough of their dream bedroom using the plan they drew on the piece of paper
7. Give the students enough time to complete their second model
8. Compare the first playdough creation with the second

Discussion

Which model is better and more detailed? It is most likely that the second one will be because they will have had time to plan and think about it before creating it with the playdough.

In the same way, doing wudu is a planning process before doing an act such as salah, which brings us closer to Allah. Doing wudu is a great time to reflect on what we are about to do for the sake of Allah, this makes our actions even more meaningful.
