

# How to Play Jeopardy

- Divide students into groups.
- Pick a category and a point value.
- Click on the chosen box for the question.
- Students must give the answer in the form of a question before clicking again. The teacher may want to set a time limit for answering the question.
- To see if a group is correct, click again for the answer.
- Click the Home button to return to the main board.
- If the group is correct, they are awarded the point value of the question. If the group gets it wrong they can even have a negative value.
- Continue until all questions have been answered.
- Final Jeopardy – each group states a value equal or less than their total points before the final jeopardy question is revealed.
- The final jeopardy is displayed and each group writes their answer in the time provided.
- Double Jeopardy is on 1 random category and value
- Double Jeopardy is worth double in positive and negative
- Sum up the points.
- The team with the most points wins.
