## A lesson on sacrifice

- 1. Give each student in the class a treat. Some suggestions:
  - a. Bag of candy
  - b. Cookies
  - c. Popcorn
  - d. A nice book and pen
  - e. A pack of markers
- 2. Tell them that they are not allowed to open it right now, they should place it on their desk
- 3. Let it be on their desk for most of the lesson
- 4. Plan ahead in asking someone to knock on your classroom door towards the end of the lesson requesting some treats that the madrasah administration require
- 5. As a teacher, act like you have to think about it, and then ask all the students for their treats back so that you can give them to the Madrasah administration
- 6. Since the treats were sitting on their desks for a while, the students have grown some attachment to them and may be reluctant to let them go.
- 7. Give all the treats to the volunteer to take away from the classroom
- 8. Quietly ask the volunteer to return the treats in 5 minutes
- 9. Return the treats to the students

## **Discussion points**

- How did you feel when you received the treat? Could you wait until you could open it and enjoy it?
- 2. How did you feel when it was taken away from you?
- 3. Imagine how Nabi Ibrahim felt when he was told to give up his own child that he loved so much
- 4. Talk about sacrifices we have to make in our own lives with our siblings, parents, grandparents friends and so on
- 5. Talk about sacrifices we have to make in our religion to please Allah, because in the end it is better for us but many times we don't realise it
- 6. Allow the students to share their experiences when they have had to make sacrifices
