What is underneath the iceberg?

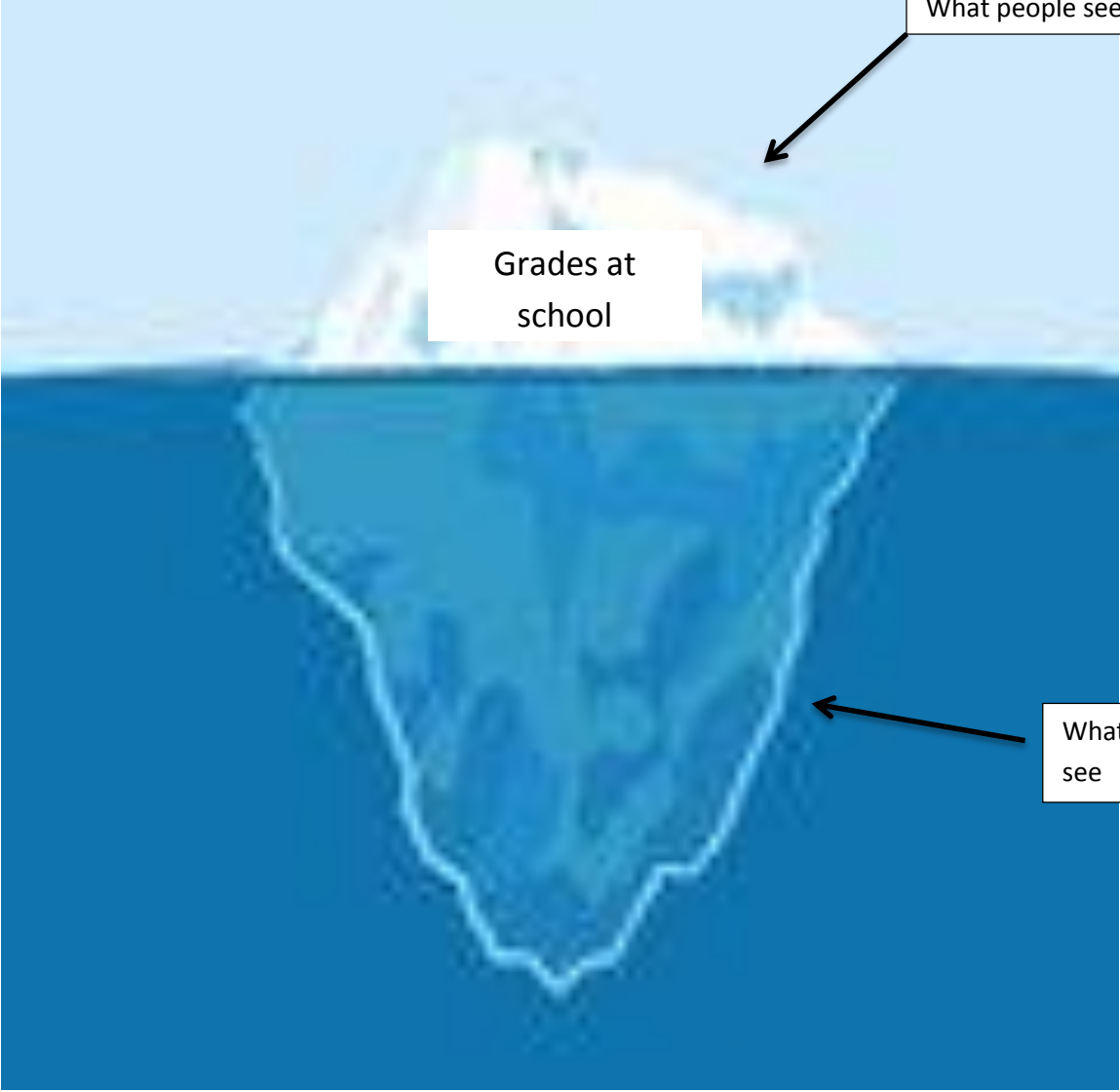
We know that an iceberg has only 10% of its total mass above the water while 90% is underwater. But that 90% is what the ocean currents act on, and what creates the icebergs behaviour at its tip.

In the same way all of us have our own icebergs as individual human beings or organisations.
