

Imam Ali ('a) says,

Do you look away when you are talking to someone

Do you talk to someone else when someone is talking to you

Are you thinking of something else when someone is talking to you...

WHY THEN WITH ALLAH (swt)

SILENCE

- Success in salaat is in
 - Talking only to Allah (swt)
 - Allowing Allah (swt) to talk to you –1 on 1
 - Observing silence, reciting only what is required and focussing your energies and attention on the salaat

WHY THEN WITH ALLAH (swt)

STILLNESS

- Success in salaat is in
 - Being as still as possible so that you can focus on talking only to Allah (swt)
 - Try the stillness exercise...

NOW PRACTICE SILENCE and STILLNESS

WHAT CAN I GET BY PRAYING

- اُذْكُرُونِي أَذْكُرْكُمْ.
- You remember Me, I will remember you." (Quran, 2:52)
- Imam Baqir ('a) says,
 - ذِكْرُ اللهِ لِأَهْلِ الصَّلاةِ أَكْبَرُ مِنْ ذِكْرِهِمْ إِيَّاهُ.
