Knowing Allah through His attributes

Play a variation of the game Taboo

- 1. Before the lesson make a copy of the clue cards given below and cut them out
- 2. Divide the class into two teams- Team A and Team B
- 3. Choose one person from Team A and give them a clue card
- 4. Their job is to get their team to guess the word on top of the card using single words, sentences, and sound effects (however they may not use the off-limit words in italics at the bottom of the card).
- 5. Once Team A has guessed the word, give a new clue card to Team B and let them do the same with their team
- 6. Continue alternating teams until all the cards are done

What did all six words have in common? They are things that are hard to see!

Ask the class:

Have you heard of the sayings? "Seeing is believing" "If I see it, I believe it. If I don't see it, I probably won't believe it"

What do you think..." Is seeing believing"?

Do you believe in Gravity? Response: Yes....But you can't see it!

Allow the students to have a discussion, ask questions and reflect on the lesson so far.

Be sure that it is about what they can see with their own eyes and not what it says in their books or on the internet. Encourage them to think of other things that they believe in but cannot see.

Organ, beat, Valentine's Day, blood, love
