- 2. Make a visual presentation of the creation you have picked
- 3. Point out the features of this creation that make it unique

An example of some research is given below (note these are just the facts, it would be nice if they were presented with pictures and diagrams):

Allah created the camel

Surah Ghashiyah 88:17 "Do they not look at the camels how they are made"

- 1. The camel is an animal that lives in the dessert that has very difficult conditions to live in
- 2. There are very few animals and insects that are able to withstand the heat and sandstorms of the dessert. Water and food are very difficult to find in the dessert
- 3. Allah has created the camel to be able to live in these conditions
- 4. The camel is able to store fat in its hump that allows it to go without food and water for up to 8 days
- 5. The foods that are found in the dessert are very coarse and rough. The camel's teeth and lips are constructed to be able to eat these sharp foods. The digestive system of the camel is also designed to digest all types of plants, therefore the camel is able to eat almost all kinds of plants
- 6. The eyelids of camels are transparent which allows them to see when their eyes are closed due to dust and sand
- 7. They have long eyelashes to protect them from blowing sand
- 8. Their noses are designed with nostrils that have lids that can shut when there is too much sand blowing
- 9. Camels feet are designed with wide toes so their feet don't sink into the sand
- 10. Their long legs keep them away from the burning floor of the dessert
- 11. Their bodies are covered with thick hard fur protecting them from the burning sun rays and the dessert chill after sunset.
