Surah Aal Imran, 3:92 لَن تَنَالُواْ الْبِرَّ حَتَّى تُنفِقُواْ مِمَّا تُحِبُّونَ وَ مَا تُنفِقُواْ مِن شَيْءٍ فَإِنَّ اللَّهَ بِهِ عَلِيمٌ You will never attain plety until you spend out of what you love; and whatever you may spend of anything, indeed Allah knows it.

- Quran specifies that one cannot become spiritually perfect and earn the pleasures of Allah unless one spends their wealth for others and gives selflessly
- ➤ Upon his reappearance Imam Mahdi (a) will create a fair & just society
- Islam has a system that helps create a greater balance between rich & poor

FORMS OF CHARITY

ZAKAH

- Zakah is Wajib tax. It literally means "purity" & "growth"
- It purifies our souls from selfishness & greed, and helps us to care about others
- Zakah is wajib on 10 things wheat, barley, dates, raisins, gold coins, sliver coins, camels, cows, sheep & business goods (based on ihtiyat-e-wajib)
- Zakah becomes wajib on the above items when they reach a minimum taxable amount
- Zakah can generally be given to the poor and needy
- Zakat al Fitr- special zakah that must be paid every year on 1st Shawwal – Eid ul Fitr

SADAQAH

- Sadaqah is generally known as "charity" and it is highly mustahabb
- There are many Quranic Ayaats and sayings of the Masoomeen (a) highlighting the importance of Sadagah
- Charity can be in any form for e.g. Money is an important form of charity, however a kind act is also considered a charity
- According to the Hadees of Rasulullah (s) the best form of charity is one which is given secretly
- The correct way of giving charity is to give it in way the makes the person receiving feel respected and dignified
