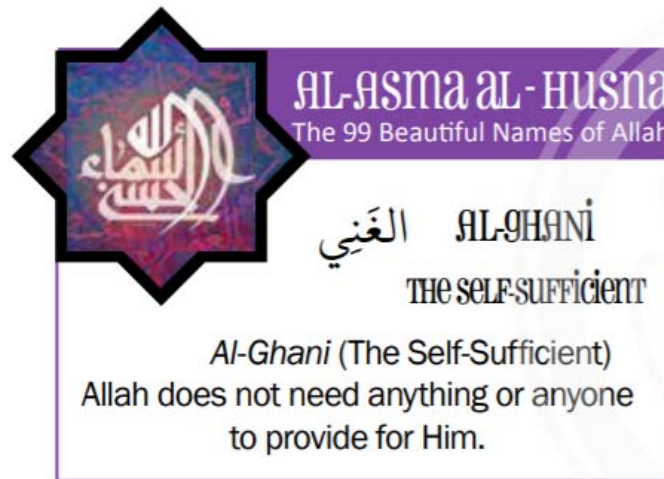

Responsibilities of Parents to their Children



- What kind of things are your parents responsible for?
 - To give the child a good name
 - To teach them tawhid
 - To teach them good akhlaq
 - To teach them the importance of the Hereafter
 - To provide them with the love, compassion, and the nurturing they need at each stage of their life
 - To familiarize them with the lives and characteristics of the ma'sumin (a)
 - To feed, clothe, and protect the child until they reach adulthood
 - To educate the child both in school and madrasah
 - To provide moral and religious training by being role models
