Allah's Set of Rules

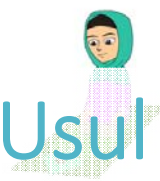


Shariah- شريعة – Set of rules from Allah to guide us through life

Furu ad-Din



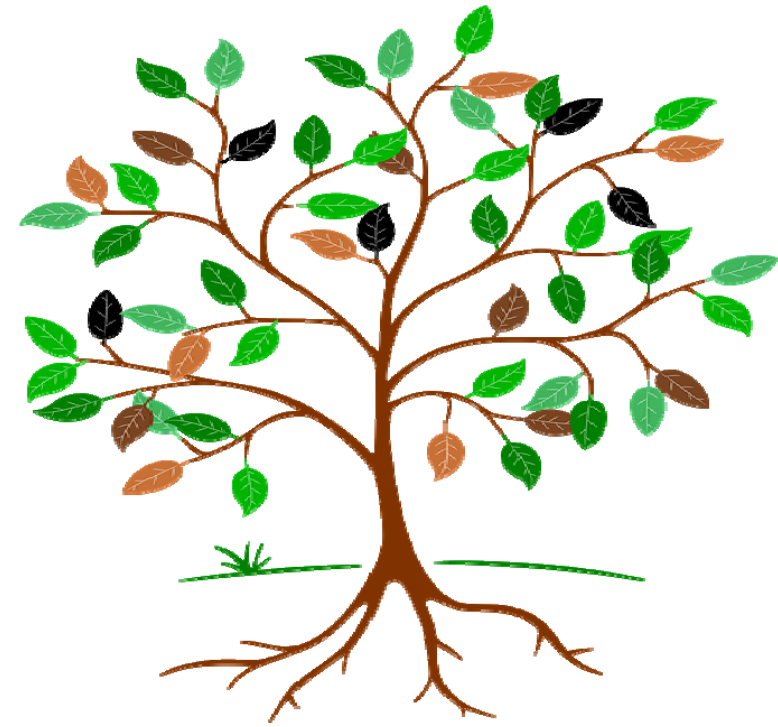
We are all Believers
