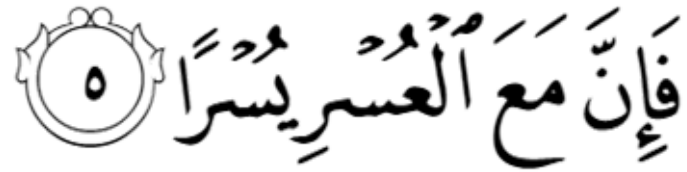


Salaam Alaykum Parents!

1.) Key points

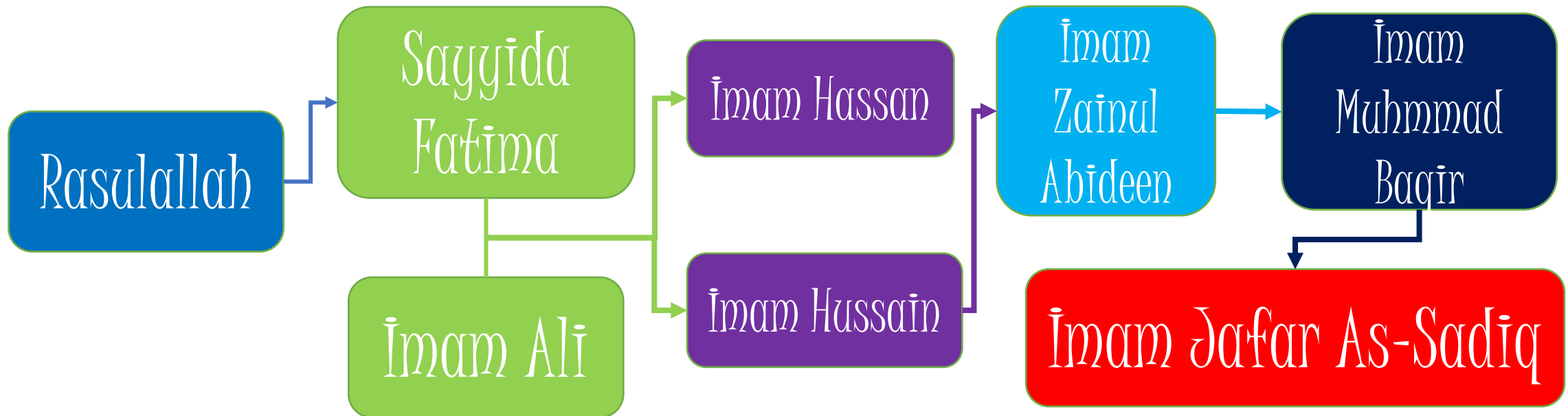
Imam Jafar As-Sadiq (as)

1 Imam Jafar As-Sadiq is our 6TH Imam

His father is Imam Muhammad Al-Baqir (as) – our fifth Imam.

2) He was given the title of ~~As-Sadiq~~ which means the truthful one

Rasulallah was also given the same title.

3) He always worked hard at everything he did

Imam Jafar As-Sadiq teaches us to work hard and try our best at everything we do.

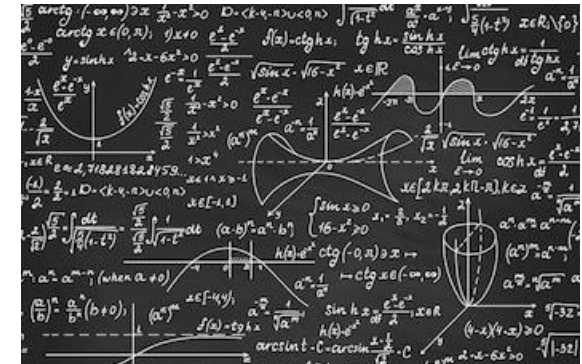

4) He worked hard to gain Knowledge

He used to sit in his father's classes even when he was a small child. He was the smartest person in the class full of much older people and understood everything perfectly. He went to his father's lectures in Islamic studies, maths and science.

Once, in a classroom full of students, Imam Muhammad al- Baqir (a) asked them, “How old is the sun?” None of the students knew- even those that were older and had been studying for a long time. Imam Jafar as- Sadiq answered “4.6 billion years old”. The 5th Imam said, “That is absolutely correct”.

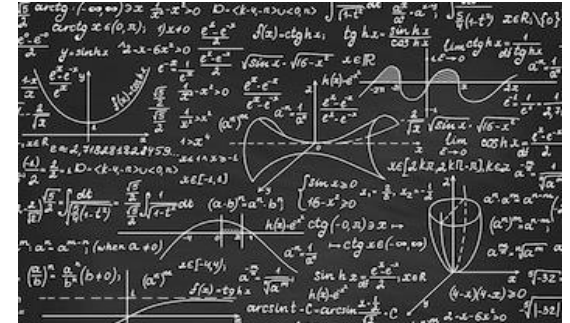

5) He worked hard to spread knowledge

Imam Ja'far as- Sadiq spread his knowledge by teaching in the schools and universities that his father had set up. He taught Islam, science, astronomy (the study of space), medicine and maths.

He also made the true version of Islam known to everyone!

People travelled from all over the world to learn from him. He was famous for being clever. He spoke to everyone in their own language! He was an incredible teacher and so many students of his became wonderful teachers after him.

6) He worked hard to Build

When the 6th Imam was a young child, Rasulallah's mosque was being extended. He asked his dad, the 5th Imam if he could help in building the mosque. Even as a child he wanted to work hard in every possible way.

7) He worked hard to farm and earn money for his family

The 6th Imam used to hard work on the fields, growing food so that he could feed his family.

He also encouraged other people to farm, explaining how it was a wonderful act and much loved by Allah.

Many of our prophets were farmers. Farming allows a country to grow its own food.

8) He worked hard to help others

After the 6th Imam worked so hard to grow dates on his farm, he would only keep what little food his family needed and would give away the rest to others!

He would always try his best to help people who were in need.

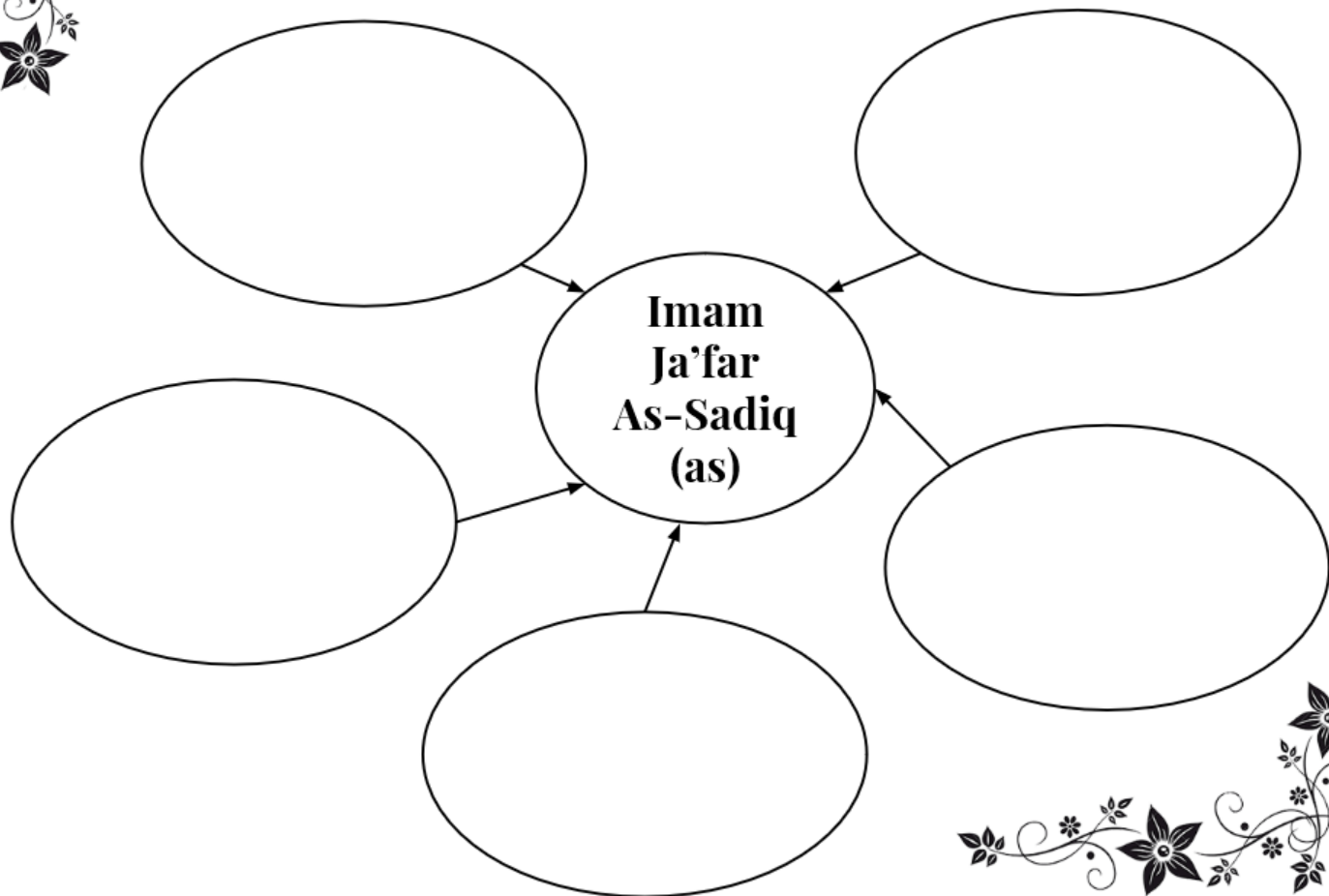
