# Course Content

The SDP is typically delivered over a single weekend and is structured into two parts:

## **Part 1 – Foundations**

This section lays the groundwork for spiritual development by introducing the key concepts, principles, and theories that underpin the journey of spiritual growth.

Participants:

- Discover the transformative role of a spiritually developed teacher
- Explore the link between knowledge, teaching, and spirituality
- Examine the soul and its major faculties
- Learn Prophetic approaches to nurturing and guiding the soul

## **Part 2 – Five-Step Programme for Spiritual Development**

Building on the foundations of Part 1, this section takes a practical approach, offering a clear, step-by-step guide to integrating spiritual development into everyday life.

Participants learn about:

- Repentance
- Self-conditioning
- Self-monitoring
- Self-accounting
- Self-deterring

**Each participant receives a Manual, a Workbook, and a Certificate from the MCE to support and recognise their learning journey.**
